The Leading Whiddon program helps our emerging leaders to develop their leadership skills and to take their career to the next level. This twelve-month program challenges, stretches and provides participants with skills and techniques that can immediately be applied in the workplace.

This integrated program assists participants to network with colleagues, consider Whiddon's business as a whole and reflect on what sort of leader they want to be. The program also allows participants to reflect on their leadership behaviours, develop plans to accelerate areas of opportunity and apply learning and concepts.

Platinum sponsor for Whiddon's Leadership for Clinical Professionals Program

This 4 month Leadership for Clinical Professionals program is unique to Whiddon and gives Registered Nurses the opportunity to enhance their clinical leadership skills through attendance at a 3 day workshop, online discussion groups and 1:1 buddy coaching.

The Leadership for Clinical Professionals program is run 3 to 4 times per year across metropolitan, rural and remote Whiddon sites in NSW and QLD.
