Your Profile

- Patience, empathy, and a caring nature.
- Basic understanding of health and safety practices.

Compliance requirements:

- Criminal Record Check (NDISWC only for required roles)
- Evidence of Flu and COVID Vaccine (desired)
- Evidence of Working Rights

Your responsibilities

As a Volunteer, your responsibilities will be discussed and agreed throughout the recruitment process. These responsibilities may include, but are not limited to:

Create Meaningful Moments	 Enrich residents' and clients' lives through conversations, reading, puzzles, and games. Engage in cultural activities, provide language support, and offer companionship through calls or pen pal connections. Your presence enriches lives with heartfelt interactions.
Wellness & Activities	 Bring enthusiasm to arts and crafts, fitness walks, and beauty sessions. Choose your favourite activities, assist with outings, and support special events. Help residents stay active, relaxed, and happy with your positive energy.
Men's Shed	 Join the Men's Shed for shared stories, laughter, and creative projects. Facilitate activities, organize the workspace, and enjoy crafting, repairing, or tinkering. Keep the energy alive and make each visit memorable
Gardening & Outdoors	 Encourage residents to enjoy nature through light gardening. Plant flowers, nurture herbs, and maintain garden spaces. Create joy with outdoor activities and share the magic of nature.
Pet Therapy Visits	Bring your friendly dog to visit residents, creating emotional connections and reducing stress. Your furry friend brings joy and companionship, brightening someone's day with their presence.
Tech & Connection Support	 Help residents stay connected with loved ones through tech support, video calls, and personal touches like birthday cards and newsletters. Maintain smooth communication and create meaningful connections.
Event support	 Support special events like theme days, BBQs, and staff celebrations. Assist with setup, coordinate activities, and provide hands-on help. Create a fun atmosphere and ensure events run smoothly.
Projects & Initiatives	 Suggest and participate in creative projects that match your interests or skills. Help with short-term projects, launch new activities, or decorate for themed events. Use your unique abilities to make a positive impact.



Restrictions on Volunteer Activities

To ensure the safety and wellbeing of our residents and clients, volunteers are not permitted to perform the following tasks:

- Administering medications or performing medical procedures
- Handling personal finances of clients
- Providing personal care services (e.g., bathing, dressing)
- Lifting or transferring residents
- Operating heavy machinery or vehicles without proper training and authorization
- Any task that requires professional qualifications or licensure that you do not possess
- While volunteers may have access to certain information, they must not handle or disclose sensitive or confidential information beyond their role's scope.

If you're ever unsure whether a task is within your scope, please consult with the Residential Services Manager or Senior Community Coordinator or reach out to Whiddon' Volunteer Manager.

- Provide feedback or raise concerns without fear of retribution.

Work Health and Safety

- Complying with Whiddon's Work Health and Safety Policies and Procedures at all times;
- Conducting themselves in line with Work Health and Safety legislative requirements at all times;
- Following reasonable directives where safety is concerned;
- Identifying and reporting hazards, incidents and safety breaches or concerns.
