Create Meaningful Moments

Enrich residents' and clients' lives through conversations. reading, puzzles, and games. Engage in cultural activities, provide language support, and offer companionship through phone call or pen pal connections.



Wellness & **Activities**

Bring enthusiasm to arts and crafts, fitness walks, and beauty sessions. Choose your favourite activities, assist with outings, and support special events. Help residents stay active, relaxed, and happy with your positive energy.



Gardening & Outdoors

Encourage residents to enjoy nature through light gardening. Plant flowers, nurture herbs, and maintain garden spaces. Create joy with outdoor activities and share the magic of nature.



Pet Therapy Visits

Bring your friendly dog to visit residents, creating emotional connections and reducing stress. Your furry friend brings joy and companionship, brightening someone's day with their presence.





Tech & Connection Support

Help residents stay connected with loved ones through tech support, video calls, and personal touches like birthday cards and newsletters. Maintain smooth communication and create meaningful connections.



Event Support

Support special events like theme days, BBQs, and employee celebrations. Assist with setup, coordinate activities, and provide hands-on help. Create a fun atmosphere and ensure events run smoothly.



Men's Shed Support

Join the Men's Shed for shared stories, laughter, and creative projects. Facilitate activities, organize the workspace, and enjoy crafting, repairing, or tinkering. Keep the energy alive and make each visit memorable.



Projects & Initiatives

Suggest and participate in creative projects that match your interests or skills. Help with short-term projects, launch new activities, or decorate for themed events. Use your unique abilities to make a positive impact.

Recognition Opportunities

We believe that acknowledging your contributions not only boosts morale but also strengthens our community. Below are the ways in which we celebrate and recognise our fantastic volunteers:

Volunteer Week

Each year, National Volunteer Week is held and is a way to nationally recognise and celebrate Volunteer's across Australia. During National Volunteer Week, all services are encouraged to arrange an event specific to their service. The National Volunteer Week event theme is consistent with the theme set by Volunteering Australia.

Milestone Awards

Recognising the milestones in our volunteers' journey is essential to fostering a sense of appreciation and belonging within our community. Starting at 5 years of service, we celebrate your dedication in 5 year increments. For each milestone reached, volunteers receive a letter and a pin reflecting their years of service, along with a gift card. The gift cards are awarded as follows:

- \$50 for 5 years of service
- \$100 for 10 years of service
- √ \$150 for 15 years of service
- \$200 for 20 years of service



Everyday Heroes Program & Board of Directors Awards

Everyday Heroes is a nomination-based recognition campaign held 3 times a year, focusing on peer-to-peer nominations but open to anyone who knows a Whiddon Everyday Hero. Local celebrations are held at the end of each campaign with everyone nominated receiving a certificate. There is one Winner per campaign, who receives a \$100 eGiftCard, and is invited to attend the Board of Directors Award Ceremony held in Sydney, where one winner is chosen, receiving \$500 an eGiftCard.

Other Recognition Opportunities

Volunteers are also encouraged to participate in on-site celebrations, such as Christmas parties and resident events like morning teas. Ask the Wellbeing and Lifestyle team or your local supervisor for a copy of the Events Calendar!

Additionally, Christmas gifts are sent to all volunteers as a sincere thank you for your invaluable contributions.

Employee Assistance

Get Paid To Refer A Friend!

Whiddon is committed to attracting talented and committed individuals into our workforce and volunteer base. To support this, we have implemented the Refer a Friend Program which incentivises employees and volunteers who refer a 'friend' (person within their known network) who successfully obtains a position with Whiddon, whether as an employee or volunteer.

Volunteers referring other volunteers or employees to Whiddon will obtain \$50, paid via online Gift Card.

Referral Criteria

The Refer a Friend Program is open to all current employees and volunteers at Whiddon. The referred person must meet the following criteria for the referring employee/volunteer to receive the incentive.

- **Employees:** Permanent positions require minimum contracted hours (16 per fortnight); casual positions require regular work (at least two shifts per month over six months).
- Volunteers: Evidence of consistent volunteering over three months.
- The referred individual must complete the probation period (six months for employees, three months for volunteers).
- Referrals must be formally flagged through PageUp or the designated referral platform.

Process Steps

Referral Submission

There are two ways to refer a friend:



Referrer

Visit our Whiddon Careers website and find the role you'd like to refer your friend to (whether paid or voluntary). Click on the role and, at the bottom of the Ad, you will find a Refer a friend button. Enter your friend's details so they can apply using the link provided in that referral.

Volunteer/Employee candidate (friend)

When completing your Application, at the end of the Application Form, you will find a question that says 'How did you hear about this opportunity?'. Select Employee/Volunteer Referral and name your referrer.



Post Hire/Engagement Process

Each month, People and Culture will review the referrals and verify the details and criteria with the respective hiring manager. Once confirmed, they will notify the referrer and process the \$50 gift card payment. Please note that no bonus will be issued if the referred volunteer leaves before completing the required period.
